John 3:5 (ESV) *Jesus answered, “Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God.”*

John 3:7-8 (ESV) *Do not marvel that I said to you, ‘You must be born again.’ The wind blows where it wishes, and you hear its sound, but you do not know*

where it comes from or where it goes. So it is with everyone who is born of the Spirit.”

John 3:9-10 (ESV) *Nicodemus said to him, “How can these things be?” Jesus answered him, “Are you the teacher of Israel and yet you do not understand these things?*

John 3:12-13 (ESV) *If I have told you earthly things and you do not believe, how can you believe if I tell you heavenly things? No one has ascended into heaven except he who descended from heaven, the Son of Man.*
